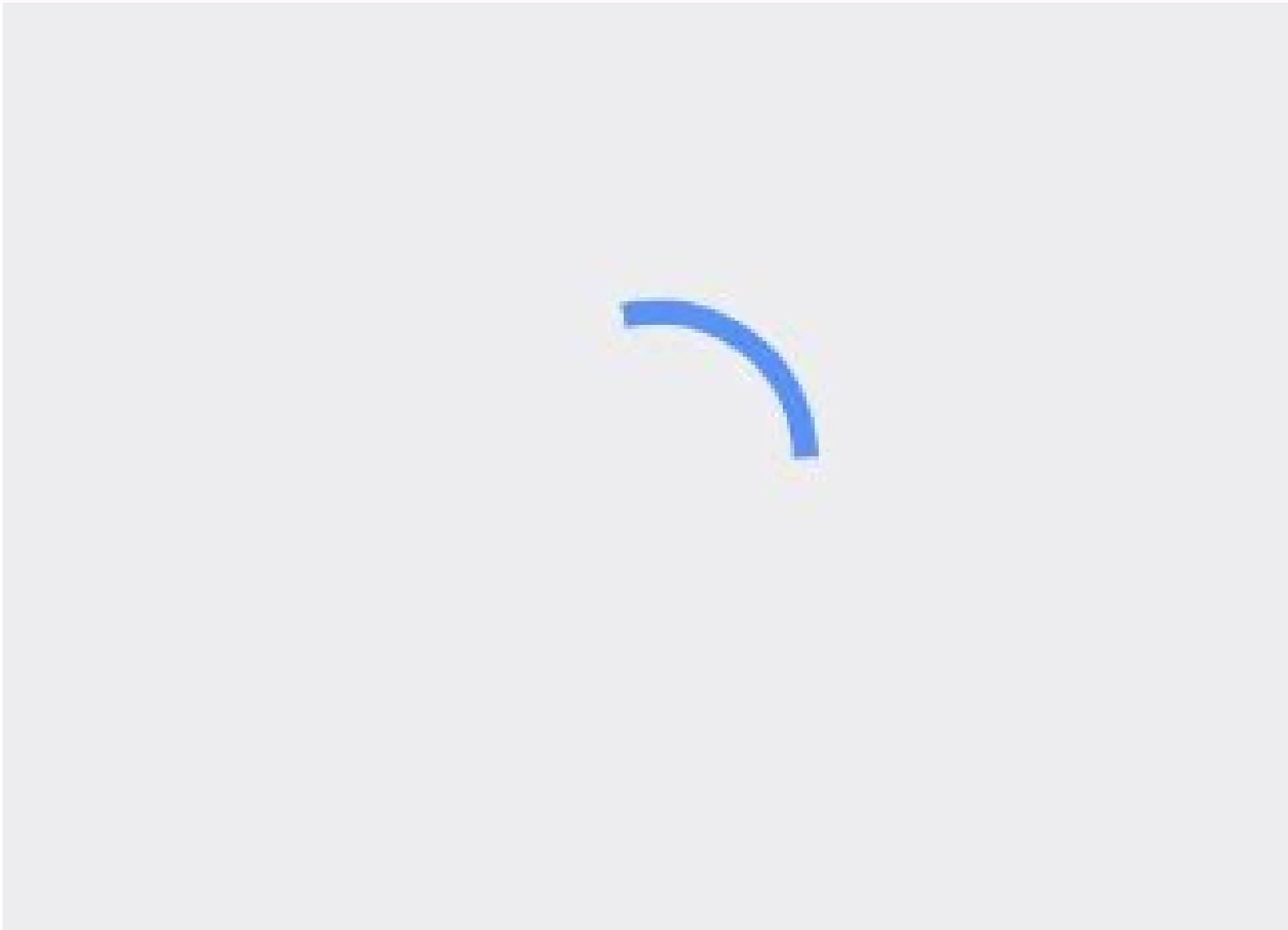
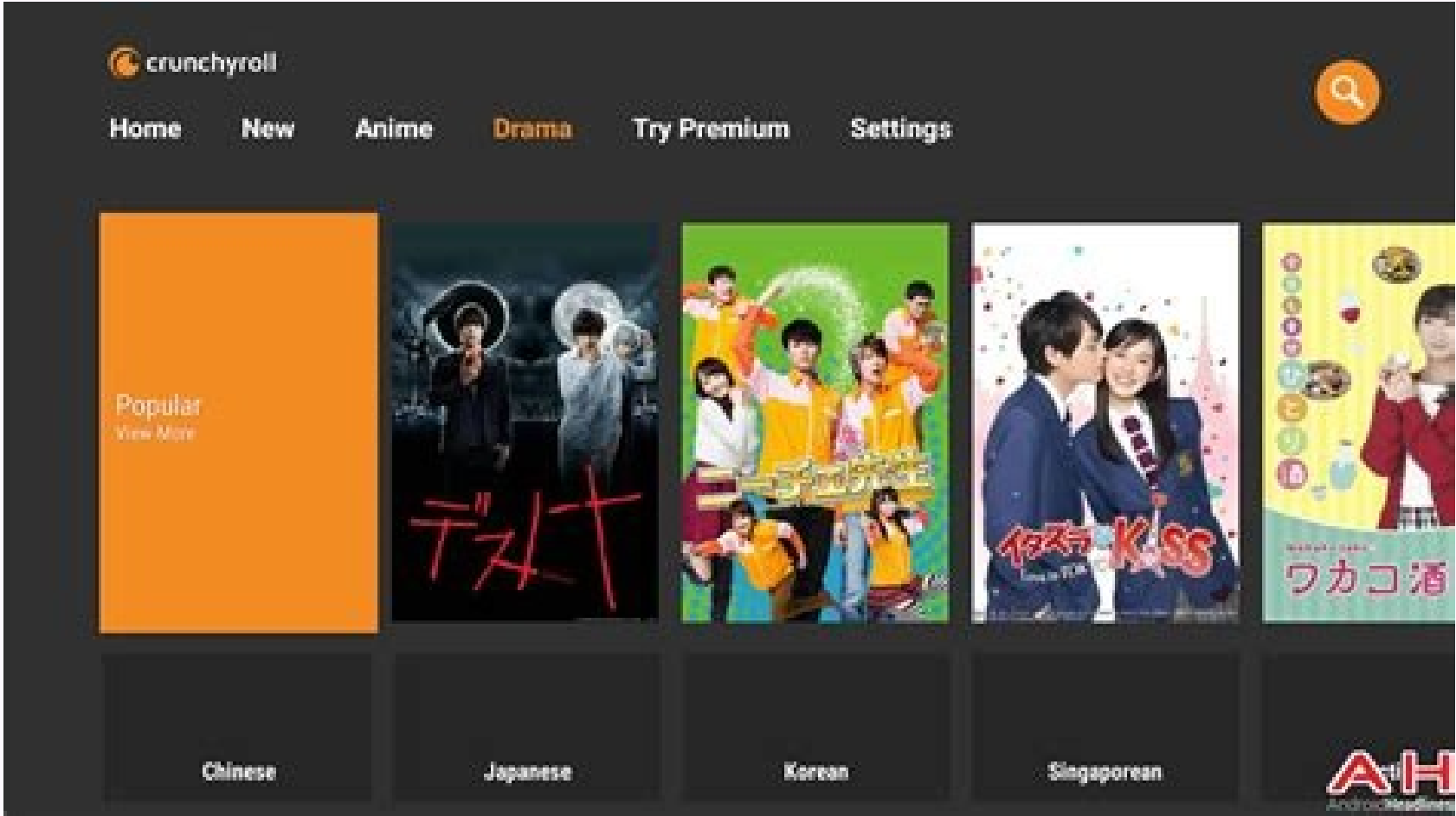

While it's true that iPadOS enjoys access to more apps that are optimized for big screens, the best Android tablets are often outstanding pieces of hardware. Google seems like it's getting serious about tablets again, with the Android big-screen improvements and a new Pixel tablet in development. You can just about spend as much or as little as you like on an Android tablet, though the pricier ones are generally more capable. There are also great Chromebooks and Chrome OS tablets that run Android apps. Thinking about buying a new tablet, but unsure which one to grab? Here are AP's top recommendations. Read More Reviews When you're talking Android tablets in the US, Samsung is the default choice. The Tab S8 series landed in February, and it's about what we expected: the Tab S8 and Tab S8+ are incremental improvements over the S7 and S7+, with similar designs and more powerful internals. But that's hardly a bad thing; we were big fans of the last generation, and better versions are, well, better. The S8 keeps all the good bits from the S7 — the premium design and build, the 120Hz display, and the bundled S Pen — while improving on its predecessor in several ways. It's considerably more powerful than the S7, with a Snapdragon 8 Gen 1 and more RAM. It also comes with Android 12 and One UI 4.1 out of the box, and it's set to get security patches until 2026 — nearly two years longer than the S7 will (that's to be expected, considering the S8 was released almost two years later, but still). If you want a premium Android tablet but don't need every bell and whistle, the S8's a great place to start your search. The main attraction is the Ultra's display: it's a huge 14.6-inch OLED panel at 1,848 by 2,960 pixels, with a refresh rate that goes all the way up to 120Hz. It's got thin bezels on all sides, but there's a notch at the top (in landscape) to accommodate dual front-facing cameras. Like the lesser S8 models, the Tab S8 Ultra packs the superfast Snapdragon 8 Gen 1 chipset. Unlike its little siblings, though, you can kit out the S8 Ultra with up to 16 gigs of RAM and 512 gigs of storage. Android's tablet apps still aren't generally super polished, but the giant screen gives you more real estate to multitask — including in Samsung DeX, which is extra handy on a screen the size of a normal laptop's. The Ultra's huge OLED is also fantastic for watching TV and movies, and its four speakers mean you'll get stereo sound in portrait or landscape orientation. It's sturdy, expensive, and very cool — a truly premium device. So if you're out to get the most Android tablet possible, the Tab S8 Ultra should be your go-to in 2022. The company has been positioning the Fire HD 10 as a productivity device. It's even got a bundle that includes a decent keyboard case, but it's probably better to think of the Fire Hd 10 as a media device first and foremost. With an older Snapdragon chipset, the P12 can't compete with the Tab S8 family on raw horsepower, but the Lenovo tablet has excellent build quality and a 1600p, 120Hz, OLED display that's fantastic for watching video or playing games. It's also not running One UI over Android, and it's the only tablet on this list where you can currently try Android 12L, a version of the OS made with large screens in mind. The Tab P12 Pro might not be the most practical option on this list, but it's got great hardware and a close-to-stock UI experience — two things that don't typically go together in Android tablets. It does run Android, but it's been tweaked to better fit the tablet's e-ink display. The primary use case for the Nova Air is reading, obviously, but it also comes with a stylus for jotting notes, and has Bluetooth so you can pair headphones for audio (the tablet has speakers, too, but they aren't very good). While it doesn't come with the Play Store pre-installed, Boox has instructions to get you started so you can download all your favorite reading apps. The tablet's 11", 2K display is sharp and just the right size for casual tablet use, and the Duet 3 comes with a detachable keyboard cover for doing more laptop-like tasks — something ChromeOS excels at. Its Snapdragon chipset provides ample horsepower for light-duty work, too. The detachable keyboard design makes using the Duet 3 in your lap a hassle, though, and its touchpad has too much drag to use comfortably for long periods of time. The base model with 64 gigabytes of storage is also hard to find, meaning you'll probably have to pony up for the 128-gig SKU at Best Buy. But if that all sounds good to you, the Duet 3 is a fine tablet for running Android apps. The Galaxy Tab S8 is an excellent place to start your search for your next Android tablet. It's well-built, as fast as you could want an Android tablet to be, and it's set to receive Android updates for four years (plus security updates for five), so you shouldn't have any trouble making the Tab S8 last. The Tab S8 Ultra has all the features in the Tab S8, but it's bigger and includes more goodies. It has the same excellent build quality and the same Snapdragon 8 Gen 1 chipset that powers some Android phones. But with a 14.6-inch display, it's positively enormous — big enough to multitask with ease. Its giant display is a 120Hz OLED panel, too, so movies look great on it. And you can get the thing with up to 16 gigs of RAM and half a terabyte of storage, which means, combined with Samsung's excellent update track record, you should have a great tablet experience for years to come. If you're after something less pricey (or less Samsung), Amazon's Fire HD 10 will be worth a look. It's not nearly as premium or as powerful as our top picks from Samsung, but it also starts at a much more palatable \$150. Just don't expect it to handle any heavy-duty tasks, the Fire HD line is more like consumption devices than productivity machines, but the warranties are good, and they're great for kids.
